KHINDIVI™ (hydrocortisone) 1 mg/mL oral solution is the only FDA-approved oral liquid hydrocortisone solution for children aged 5 years and older with adrenal insufficiency.

KHINDIVI is not approved for stress dosing.

USE

KHINDIVI is a prescription medicine used in children 5 years of age and older as replacement therapy when the adrenal gland is not making enough cortisol.

Limitation of Use: KHINDIVI is not approved for increased dosing during periods of stress or acute events. Use a different hydrocortisone-containing drug product for stress dosing.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Always give KHINDIVI exactly as your doctor has directed.

Do not take KHINDIVI if you are allergic to hydrocortisone or any of its other ingredients.

Adrenal Crisis: Giving too low a dose or stopping medication can cause low levels of cortisol, which can result in serious illness or death. Treatment with intravenous hydrocortisone should be started immediately. When switching from another type of hydrocortisone to KHINDIVI, watch your child closely for any changes. During periods of stress such as infections or after surgery, your doctor should switch to another oral hydrocortisone product and increase the dose.

Accurate hydrocortisone dosing is critical

Adrenal insufficiency occurs when the body can't make enough cortisol and, in some cases, other vital hormones. Delivering the right amount of hydrocortisone is essential to keeping children with adrenal insufficiency healthy. Therefore, it's important to give the precise dose prescribed by your child's doctor.



Overdosing

Too much hydrocortisone can lead to*:

- Growth issues
- High blood pressure
- Abnormal weight gain



Underdosing

Not enough hydrocortisone can lead to*:

- Adrenal crisis
- Poor stress response
- Weight loss

Even minor errors in hydrocortisone dosing may cause serious health problems, which can lead to serious illness or death.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Systemic Adverse Reactions Due to Inactive Ingredients

Hyperosmolality: KHINDIVI is not approved in children less than 5 years of age. The inactive ingredients in KHINDIVI can cause dangerous fluid imbalances.

Metabolic Acidosis and Other Adverse Reactions: Some ingredients in KHINDIVI may cause a build-up of acid in the body, low blood sugar, or injuries to the liver, kidneys, or brain, that may increase the risk of adrenal crisis.

Laxative Effects Due to Inactive Ingredients: Some ingredients in KHINDIVI may cause stomach upset resulting in vomiting and/or diarrhea and could increase the risk of adrenal crises in patients.

Immunosuppression and Increased Risk of Infection With Use of a Dosage Greater Than Replacement: Use of a greater than replacement dosage can suppress the immune system and increase the risks of new infections. Contact your health care provider if any infections develop.

Your doctor has prescribed KHINDIVI

KHINDIVI™ (hydrocortisone) 1 mg/mL oral solution is liquid hydrocortisone made for children aged 5 years and older with adrenal insufficiency.

As a liquid hydrocortisone treatment, KHINDIVI helps enable accurate dosing every time[†] by removing the need to compound (combine or mix) medicine or split or crush tablets. It offers a convenient, ready-to-use liquid that's ideal for accurate dosing on the go.

KHINDIVI is not approved for increased dosing during periods of stress or acute events. Ask your doctor about using a different cortisol replacement for stress dosing.

KHINDIVI can also be administered through a **gastric tube**.

Gastric tubes should be flushed with water following administration to ensure that the entire dose is delivered.

KHINDIVI can be stored at room temperature (68°F to 77°F) or refrigerated (36°F to 46°F) if preferred.

What makes KHINDIVI different

Q: How is KHINDIVI different from a medicine that's mixed or combined in the pharmacy?

A: Pharmacies compound, or pre-mix, medicines to meet unique patient needs, but custom medicines can vary each time they're made. KHINDIVI™ (hydrocortisone) 1 mg/mL oral solution is made the same way every time, so you always get the same dose with no extra steps.

Q: Does KHINDIVI need refrigeration, mixing, or shaking?

A: KHINDIVI is a shelf-stable, ready-to-use formulation. It's designed for easy storage at home or during travel. KHINDIVI is designed to help minimize the potential for medication errors that can lead to over- or underdosing. Each bottle of KHINDIVI should be used within 120 days of receipt. Throw away any KHINDIVI that has not been used within this time frame.

Q: Is KHINDIVI safer or more reliable than a pre-mixed medicine?

A: Compounded medicines (medicines that have been combined or mixed) can be less reliable because they're made in smaller batches by individual pharmacies, which means each dose might be a little different. This can make it harder to know exactly how the medicine will work, potentially affecting a child's treatment and health. KHINDIVI is designed to help avoid these potential problems so you can focus less on treatment and more on the well-being of your child.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Growth Retardation: The long-term use of corticosteroids in high doses may cause growth retardation in children.

Decrease in Bone Density: Corticosteroids can affect your child's bone growth and strength.

Cushing's Syndrome Due to High Doses of Corticosteroids: Treatment with high doses of corticosteroids can cause Cushing's Syndrome. Treatment should be limited to the smallest dose required, and your child's growth and development monitored appropriately.

Psychiatric Changes: Corticosteroids can change your child's behavior or mood. Tell your doctor if your child has periods of extreme happiness, extreme sadness, hallucinations, or depression.

How to get started with KHINDIVI

Your doctor will send your prescription to Anovo® Specialty Pharmacy. Anovo will then follow up with your doctor's office to gather the information required for the benefits process.

Within the next 3 days, you can expect



A nurse ambassador will call you before the medication ships to help you get started.



An Anovo pharmacist will also call to explain how the medicine works and arrange delivery.



Four days after the medicine is shipped, a nurse ambassador will call again to see if you have additional questions.



To help families stay on track, Anovo will stay in contact about medication refills and deliveries.

Medication may arrive in as soon as 24 hours*

*For new enrollees with private insurance who are experiencing an acute significant health event as documented by their physician, medication may be delivered in as soon as 24 hours. Typical delivery is 3 to 7 days.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Changes in Vision: Tell your doctor if your child has blurred vision or other vision problems during treatment with KHINDIVI.

Gastrointestinal Adverse Reactions: Tell the doctor if your child has stomach pain, upset stomach, black, tarry stools, or vomiting of blood. These could be signs of ulcers or tears in the stomach or intestines. Taking anti-inflammatory nonsteroidal drugs, like ibuprofen, naproxen, or aspirin, can increase the risk of ulcers or tears.

The most common side effects of KHINDIVI include retaining fluids, changes in glucose tolerance, high blood pressure, behavioral and mood changes, greater appetite, and weight gain.
